

THE MILL



Cycle **BALLYMONEY**

Starting Point: Drumaheglis Marina

Approx. Distance: 4.5 miles

Directions: Turn left onto Glenstall Road, at T-junction turn right over railway and continue through MacFin Village. Take a right turn at crossroads into Taughey Road (or continue straight ahead for 3/4 mile to visit Leslie Hill Open Farm, which is on the right hand side). Following the Taughey Road, continue to the next T-junction making a right turn onto Balnamore Road. Continue through Balnamore Village to the next T-junction, looking out for the chimney at Balnamore Mill. Turn right into Glenstall Road and continue on to entrance of marina.

Historic points of interest to look out for along your way include: Archaeologists have found evidence that Mesolithic people built settlements along the banks of the River Bann at Drumaheglis. They have also discovered traces of Mediaeval buildings.

During the 1830s, Drumaheglis distillery produced 50,000 - 60,000 gallons of whiskey every year.
