

DRUMAHEGLIS NATURE



A short, pleasant woodland nature trail adjacent to the River Bann set within the Drumaheglis Marina and Caravan Park complex.



ROUTE TYPE: Riverside, Woodland.

ROUTE DESCRIPTION: From the marina car park follow the nature trail sign to a track through the woodland. This informal path swings around the outside edge of the existing woodland area and offers a short, quiet walk, good for families with small children. On returning to the car park why not take the time to stop and enjoy this beautiful riverside site. Have a picnic on the banks of the River Bann or just enjoy refreshments from the shop while the children have fun in the play area.

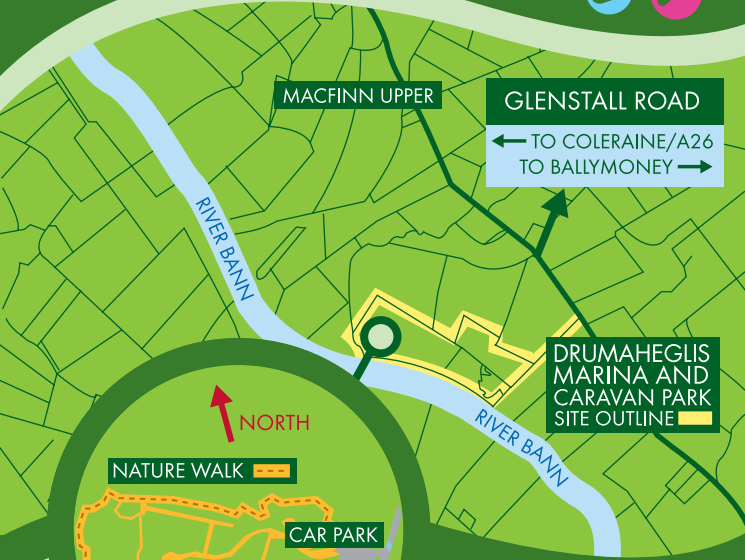
ACCESS INFORMATION: From Ballymoney Town Centre follow Charlotte Street and Balnamore Road to Balnamore village and pick up the brown tourist attraction signs for Drumaheglis Marina.

FACILITIES: The nature trail is open for walking all year round. From St. Patrick's weekend until Halloween, 9.00am to 8.30pm (July & August 9.00am to 10.00pm), visitors can avail of the site facilities including toilets, car park and shop.
