



RIVERSIDE PARK



Riverside Park offers a variety of walks through various landscapes including woodland. The Ballymoney River runs through the middle of the park.



ROUTE TYPE: Parkland.

ROUTE DESCRIPTION: Riverside Park is a superb open space with 40 acres of parkland crossed with both formal and informal paths suitable for all users and it is a quality accredited walking route. From the main car park at Armour Avenue visitors can enjoy a short walk around the duck pond and wildfowl sanctuary and feed some of the many resident ducks and geese. For a longer walk turn left, passing the children's play area, and follow a wide shared use path, also great for cyclists, out to Bravallen Road and back. Alternatively, a right turn from Armour Avenue will take you under the existing road bridge and into Rodeing Foot Woodland where the Ballymoney River is crossed by several accommodation bridges. This walk has recently been extended under the existing railway via a tunnel and along the river as far as the A26 Bypass. Walkers can then make their way along the Kirk Road and down Greengage Lane back to the railway tunnel. For the really enthusiastic walker why not combine the routes for a 3 mile long figure-of-eight circuit and take full advantage of the variety offered by Ballymoney's very own "green gym".

ACCESS INFORMATION: From the town centre follow signs for the Joey Dunlop Leisure Centre. At Rodeing Foot take a right turn into Armour Avenue just before Trolan's Garage, the car park is on the right.

FACILITIES: Two car parks, toilets and children's play area.
